£5,000 BRYAN MARSH GOLD DEVELOPMENT AWARD

1. Aim of the Award.

The BRYAN MARSH GOLD DEVELOPMENT AWARD is an award given to a Welsh person, generally under the age of 30, of demonstrated ability who presents a proposal which will permit development of his or her career or business.

2. Criteria to be met.

The criteria to be meet for selection are deliberately drawn widely but will include the following requirements: -

2.1 General.

- Welshness shall be established subject to the criteria accepted by the Awards Committee.
- Nominated candidates can include members of the disciplined and civilian services.
- The nominated candidates shall have at least two referees of good standing.
- The financial need of the applicant, although assessed, will only be in general terms.
- The Award shall not be made to a candidate at the start of higher education.
- The Award shall be of greater benefit to the candidate than the monetary value alone.

2.2 Sustained personal achievement.

- The demonstrated achievement shall be substantially greater than would normally be expected for the age, position and education of the peer group of the applicant.
- The achievement shall be assessed for sustained excellence

2.3 Potential for further development.

- Potential for further development shall be a major consideration.
- The successful candidate shall state the use to which this Award will be used.
- The Award shall be used to further the development of the successful candidate.

The closing date for applications is the 17th November 2023. Interviews of those shortlisted will be held soon after that date and the winner will be announced in March 2024.
