THE SILVER JUBILEE DEVELOPMENT AWARD

The topic for the 2023-2024 Award is:

ARCHITECTURE and the BUILT ENVIRONMENT

Applications for this Award, of £2,500, are now invited.

Closing date is 30th November 2023.

Objective of the Award: To enable an outstanding young person, who has already studied aspects of architecture and building successfully, to further their academic or professional development by undertaking *an innovative, self-contained and well-defined project.* The project may be stand alone or part of a course of postgraduate/professional study which will help them build their career in Architecture and the Built Environment.

Eligibility: Young people aged 21 – 25, with possible extension to 30 if the candidate is or has been a postgraduate student. Candidates must have an association or commitment to Wales evidenced by a combination of birth, residence, education, or employment (but not necessarily all four). People with a Welsh connection who have completed a first degree in a relevant subject from university or School of Architecture outside of Wales or who currently work outside of Wales may be eligible to apply.

Subject Area: Projects need to focus on topics related to the **art and technique** of designing and building, as distinguished from the skills associated with construction (which are supported by other Awards given by the Company).

The Award: Has a monetary value of £2,500 which must be spent on a project which will be completed before the end of 2024. Projects which form part of a post graduate academic course or a young person's professional development may be eligible, including travel costs, so long as the project is well defined and results in distinct output. Projects may include travelling to study outstanding areas of architectural design and attending and presenting at conferences. Innovative projects will be welcomed.

The Award cannot be used to pay all or part of academic or professional development course fees.

The winner of the Award will receive a Prestigious Award Certificate and an invitation to a significant Livery Company event. Recipients of the Award must agree to provide a report detailing the use to which the Award funds have been put and what they have learned within three months of completion of the project.
