## NSPCC

**Our direct work with children**

We worked directly with **15k children and families**, delivering services such as **Pregnancy in Mind** in Wales

**Child Protection in Sport Unit**

Across the UK, we assisted **nearly 200 sporting organisations** to develop and embed safeguarding policies and procedures

**Professional Learning Services**

Alongside other training and consultancy offers, **85 organisations** completed a **National Training Programme in Wales**

**NSPCC Learning**

We provided **information, resources and courses** for professionals and people working with children through **over 2.8 million visits** to our website

**The NSPCC Helpline**

The NSPCC Helpline responded to **over 75,000 contacts** from people, across the UK, with concerns about a child's welfare

**Child safety online**

We are working to keep children safe online. This includes **campaigning, and support for parents**

**Partnerships**

We worked with local organisations in **the UK** to help make our communities safer for children

Through a tailor-made approach, we ran **Together for Childhood**, and the **Young Witness Service**

**Supporting Schools**

**30,066 children** in **201 schools** took part in our online **Speak out** Stay safe programme in Wales

**Local campaigns**

In **Wales**, we engaged around **2,600 professionals, adults and children** through local campaigns including **LSSP Cym Taf Mogaerwy**

**Scale up**

We have licensed, trained and supported **15 partner organisations** in **Wales** to deliver services such as the **Graded Care-Profile 2 and Reunification**

**Childline**

Our Childline volunteers delivered **almost 200,000 counselling sessions** to children and young people

We estimate around **5,500** of these children lived in **Wales**, based on the **74%** of counselling sessions where the nation was known
